Updated: Ongoing Utility Location Work on Clarke Road between Glenayre Drive and Thompson Avenue

As part of the Evergreen Line tunnel construction, crews are continuing to confirm the location of utilities underneath Clarke Road between Glenayre Drive and Thompson Avenue.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will be removing the concrete median traffic islands to confirm the location of utilities in this area. This work will take approximately a day to complete.
- Work will occur within a one week period starting on **May 11**. Crews will not be working on Sunday.
- While work is underway, daytime lane closures on Clarke Road between Glenayre Drive and Thompson Avenue will be in effect from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. All lanes will be open during the a.m. and p.m. peak travel periods.
- Nearby residents can expect noise related to hydro-vacuuming, saw-cutting, excavation, and the use of heavy machinery. Every effort will be made to minimize noise and disruptions.
- Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to please watch for construction signs and follow the directions of traffic control personnel while work is underway. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be on-site to assist drivers when required.
- Access to residents' homes will be maintained.

Residents living adjacent to the tunnel alignment will be updated on tunnel boring operations and what to expect once the tunnel boring machine advances near your community.
