Update on Tunnel Construction

The tunnel boring machine (TBM) is currently under Clarke Road at Seaview Drive and will resume boring in early September. The TBM will continue to move south under Clarke Road toward Glenayre Drive and break through at the south tunnel portal located just south of Kemsley Avenue on the west side of Clarke Road.

Once boring is well underway, crews will begin decommissioning the work site at Clarke Road and Seaview Drive.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Tunnel boring will be a 24-hours-a-day operation, seven days a week.
- The TBM will continue to be approximately 40 metres below the surface when it starts up at Seaview Drive and Clarke Road.
- Residents may experience some noise and vibration when the TBM starts up and leaves your area. Residents may feel a low rumble that stops and starts intermittently.
- When boring resumes, lane closures on Clarke Road at Seaview Drive will remain in effect.
- Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to continue watching for construction signs and follow the directions of traffic control personal while work is underway.
- Decommissioning of the dewatering wells and the work site is scheduled to occur approximately three weeks after boring starts. This will include the removal of the drill rig casings, pumps, hoses and ramps and the removal of equipment. This will take approximately two weeks to complete.
- Once the dewatering wells have been decommissioned, crews will restore the roadway and re-open Seaview Drive to the west of Clarke Road. This will take approximately one week to complete.
- Please note, paving requires warm and dry weather conditions, so this work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.
- More information will be available closer to the start of this work.
