Cecile Drive Update

Evergreen Line crews will complete restoration of Cecile Drive starting on **Friday, September 11**. Crews will be reconstructing curbs and restoring the landscaping on the south side of Cecile Drive just west of Highview Place.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will start the final restoration work on Friday, September 11 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and work will take one to two days.
- While this work is underway, there will be single lane alternating traffic on Cecile Drive just west of Highview Place. Access to residents' homes will be maintained.
- Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to please watch for construction signs and follow the directions of traffic control personal while work is underway.
- There will also be temporary no-parking restrictions on the south side of Cecile Drive this Friday. Please watch for signs indicating the dates and times when parking restrictions are in effect.
- Nearby residents can expect noise related to construction activities, including the use of heavy machinery.
- Every effort will be made to minimize noise and disruption and to complete this work as soon as possible.
