Ongoing Tunnel Construction at the North Portal Area

Boring of the two-kilometre tunnel for the Evergreen Line is complete and crews have begun the next stage of tunnel construction at the north portal area. Dismantling of the equipment used as part of boring operations has commenced. This will be followed by construction in the tunnel, which includes building a concrete base and a centre wall to separate trains travelling in opposite directions.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Dismantling of the tunnel boring equipment and ongoing tunnel construction will be 24 hours a day, seven days a week for approximately four months.
- Construction activities at the north tunnel portal area will include:
 - Dismantling the tunnel boring machine's conveyor belt system.
 - Removing power cables and ventilation systems that were used as part of boring operations.
 - Gravel and concrete deliveries to the work site.
 - Tunnel interior work, which includes constructing the concrete base and centre wall within the tunnel.
- Large cranes will be used to for the removal of the tunnel boring equipment, and to prepare the site for the tunnel interior work.
- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise related to these activities including the use of heavy machinery, material handling equipment, truck movements and generators.
- Every effort will be made to minimize noise and complete noisier activities related to material hauling during the daytime; however, nighttime work will occur.
- Every effort will be made to minimize the impact of back-up beepers, including using flag persons to assist with the maneuvering of trucks, and using variable-volume back-up beepers on trucks and equipment where possible.
- When crews are working at night, construction lighting will be used and efforts will be made to angle the lighting to minimize effects on nearby residents.

TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES

As part of the work at the north portal, the following traffic pattern changes will be in effect:

- Trucks hauling gravel and concrete will continue to access the worksite from Barnet Highway. Hauling will be done during the daytime as much as possible.
- Access to the tunnel work area will be controlled by traffic control personnel working at the site.
- Intermittent daytime lane closures of one southbound lane on Barnet Highway will be required as part of this work.
- Temporary two-minute stoppages of traffic on View Street and Barnet Highway may be required to maneuver trucks and equipment in and out of the work site. Traffic control personnel will be on-site to direct drivers.
- For the safety of all drivers, please watch for construction signs, drive with caution and follow the directions of traffic control personnel. Traffic control personnel will assist drivers wishing to access Barnet Highway from View Street as required.
- Temporary parking restrictions on View Street may be required. Please watch for signs indicating the dates and times when parking restrictions are in place.

When construction of the concrete base and the centre wall within the tunnel are complete, trackwork and power systems in the tunnel will be installed.
