Start of Plaza Construction at Moody Centre Station

Moody Centre Station is almost complete, and Evergreen crews will now begin construction of the Moody Centre Station plaza. The work will take place from mid-April to late August 2016.

The permanent entrance to the station to access the West Coast Express platform was opened to the traveling public the week of April 11. Passengers are reminded that construction at Moody Centre Station is ongoing. While the majority of the station construction is complete, there is finishing work and plaza construction that will occur around the WCE schedule.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Station plaza construction will take place Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. If night work is required, residents and businesses will be notified in advance.
- Plaza work includes finishing pedestrian walkways, the installation of bike racks, landscaping, public seating and public art.
- Nearby residents and businesses may experience noise related to construction activities, including the use of heavy machinery. Every effort will be made to minimize noise and disruptions where possible.
- Pedestrians are asked to follow the marked detours during plaza construction.
- Bus riders can expect changes to bus stop locations in the transit loop during this work. Please check the bus stop posts for information on the changes.
