CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC BULLETIN

Port Moody

Cecile Drive Open with Single Lane Alternating Traffic

Cecile Drive, just west of Highview Place, opened with single lane alternating traffic on **Tuesday, February 10**. The tunnel boring machine (TBM) maintenance below Cecile Drive is anticipated to be completed this week. Once the maintenance is complete, the TBM will resume boring. The final road restoration of Cecile Drive will follow and more information will be provided. Please check the Evergreen Line website for updates

TRAFFIC DETOURS

- Traffic control personnel will continue to be on site to assist drivers. Drivers, cyclists and pedestrians are asked to watch for construction signs, proceed with caution and follow the directions of traffic control personnel.
- Bus stops will be returned to their original locations.
- The temporary parking restrictions on the south side of Cecile Drive will remain in effect until Cecile Drive is fully reopened.

TUNNEL BORING MACHINE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS

- Localized dewatering will continue until the TBM maintenance is complete. Blue fencing will remain around the work area.
- Noise related to construction activities will include pumps, generators, air compressors, material hauling and the use of heavy machinery and will be in effect from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., Monday through Friday and on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Hyrdo-vac and tanker trucks may also be used as part of this process. Crews will work on Sundays only if required.

CECILE DRIVE RESTORATION

- We will provide an update on the opening of two lane traffic on Cecile Drive in the next week or two.
