Port Moody

Road Restoration and Paving Work on Cecile Drive

As part of ongoing Evergreen Line construction, crews will be restoring and paving a section of Cecile Drive the week of August 24. The road restoration and paving will take approximately two days to complete.

Paving requires warm and dry weather conditions, so this work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- There will be two days of work during the week of August 24 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The start of Cecile Drive work is dependent on the completion of road restoration work at Chateau Place. Crews will likely start on either Tuesday, August 25 or Wednesday, August 26.
- While this work is underway, there will be lane closures on Cecile Drive just west of Highview Place. Access to residents' homes will be maintained.
- Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to please watch for construction signs and follow the directions of traffic control personal while work is underway.
- When lane closures are in effect, there will be temporary no-parking restrictions on the south side of Cecile Drive. Please watch for signs indicating the dates and times when parking restrictions are in effect.
- Nearby residents can expect noise related to construction activities, including the use of heavy machinery.
