Restoration and Paving Work – Clarke Road at Seaview Drive

Evergreen Line crews will begin restoring the work site and paving a section of Clarke Road at Seaview Drive starting **the week of September 28**. The restoration and paving will take approximately three weeks to complete. Please note, paving requires warm and dry weather conditions, so this work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work will take place Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Restoration and paving work will take approximately three weeks to complete.
- Crews will begin with the decommissioning of the dewatering wells and the work site. This will include the removal of the drill rig casings, pumps, hoses and ramps and the removal of equipment.
- Once the dewatering wells have been decommissioned, road restoration will start. Crews will be removing the existing asphalt in the roadway and adding granular fill and compacting this material as needed.
- Once the fill has been placed, crews will pave and repaint the lane markings on Clarke Road. Milling may be required in some areas.
- While this work is underway, one lane in each direction will be maintained at all times. Traffic will be shifted either to the east side (when crews are paving southbound lanes) or west side (when crews are paving northbound lanes) of Clarke Road.
- When traffic is shifted to the east side of Clarke Road to accommodate decommissioning of the dewatering wells and for paving work, access to and from Seaview Drive on the east side will be temporarily unavailable. Local residents wishing to access Seaview Drive to the east will be detoured to Seaforth Way.
- Access to Seaview Drive on the west side of Clarke Road will re-open upon completion of the restoration and paving.
- Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to please watch for construction signs and follow the directions of traffic control personnel while work is underway.
- Nearby residents can expect construction-related noise, including the use of heavy equipment and material hauling. Crews will minimize the use of back-up beepers, however they are required for safety. Every effort will be made to minimize noise and disruption and to complete this work as soon as possible.
