CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC BULLETIN

Coquitlam

Deliveries and Construction at the South Tunnel Portal

Starting on Wednesday, **October 28**, Evergreen Line construction crews will be delivering materials and assembling the formwork panels for the construction of the center wall in the tunnel that will separate trains travelling in opposite directions.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- There will be approximately three days of deliveries of the formwork panels within a one month period. Daytime lane closures on Clarke Road southbound just south of Thompson Avenue will be in effect when deliveries occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- When these lane closures are in effect, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are requested to obey the instructions of traffic control personnel, be cautious of trucks exiting and entering the construction area and watch for traffic signs.
- Daytime construction activities related to the assembly of the formwork will take place Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. and if needed on Sundays and holidays from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. This work is expected to take approximately one month.
- Nearby residents can expect noise related to construction activities, including the use of power tools, trucks, lifting equipment and back-up beepers which are a safety requirement.
- Every effort will be made to minimize disruption when possible and to keep the area clean, including dust suppression.

More detailed information about tunnel boring operations and tunnel related construction activities will be made available in the near future prior to the tunnel boring machine's arrival at the south tunnel portal area.
