



STATION UPDATES

Coquitlam Central Station

Coquitlam Central Station is located within the existing Coquitlam transit exchange site, providing convenient connections to adjacent Park and Ride facilities, West Coast Express and local and regional bus service. Located just east of the Johnson Street / Mariner Way overpass and north of the railway tracks, this location allows for a future extension to Port Coquitlam.

Coquitlam Central Station's entrance is surrounded by a pedestrian-friendly plaza. The station's tiered roof and extensive use of wood have also been designed to reflect natural features around the station. Once inside the station, Evergreen Line passengers will access the platforms by stairs, elevators and escalators.

Coquitlam Central Station will have dedicated areas for passenger pick-up and drop-off located north of the station entrance. The existing pick-up and drop-off area at the existing Coquitlam Central West Coast Express Station will also be available to Evergreen Line passengers.

Pedestrians will access the Evergreen Line through the east end of the station. Sidewalks and new pedestrian crossings within the transit exchange site will connect the station entrance to the existing bus loop and Coquitlam Centre Mall and the retail area north of Barnet Highway. A pull-out bay adjacent to the station entrance will accommodate HandyDART service.

Coquitlam Central Station will feature bike lockers and racks that will be conveniently located in the station plaza area, near to the station entrance. These will be in addition to the existing racks and lockers near the West Coast Express station and transit exchange area.

A new overflow Park and Ride parking lot will be constructed west of the station, with a pedestrian access into the station. This parking lot will provide approximately 305 new parking stalls to the west of Coquitlam Central Station, in addition to 110 new parking stalls within the existing parking lot.

What is the Evergreen Line?

The Evergreen Line project is an 11-kilometre extension to the existing SkyTrain system in Metro Vancouver. It will be a fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service, connecting Coquitlam City Centre through Port Moody to Lougheed Town Centre in approximately 15 minutes. It will connect without transfer to the current SkyTrain network at Lougheed Town Centre Station and will integrate with regional bus and West Coast Express networks. When the line opens, Metro Vancouver's SkyTrain system will become the longest fully automated rapid transit system in the world.
