



STATION UPDATES

Lincoln Station

Lincoln Station is located adjacent to Coquitlam Centre Mall on Pinetree Way between Lincoln Avenue and Northern Avenue, and across from the City Centre Library. Located in the heart of a growing commercial and residential area of Coquitlam, Lincoln Station will serve the mall and more than a dozen existing and planned residential and retail developments located within a short walk of the station.

The new station supports the planning goals outlined in the city of Coquitlam’s Official Community Plan for the City Centre to become a sustainable, high density urban core. Lincoln Station is being funded through a unique partnership between the Government of Canada, the City of Coquitlam and the owners of Coquitlam Centre Mall.

Lincoln Station features extensive glass and well-lit areas allowing passengers to remain visible and safe while travelling on the Evergreen Line. The station entrance will be located at the north end of the station at Northern Avenue and Pinetree Way. The Evergreen Line Project is working with the City of Coquitlam to incorporate the local area plan features into the station plaza area, creating an integrated look and feel. The city is constructing a multiuse path that will integrate with the plaza to create a pedestrian and cyclist corridor.

Once inside the station, Evergreen Line passengers may access the side platforms by stairs, elevator or escalators. Lincoln Station will also have bike racks and lockers for cyclists. The bus stop along the east side of the station on Pinetree Way will serve residents and transit passengers as they connect to the existing transit system from Lincoln Station. Along the west side of the station, there will be a dedicated stop for HandyDART service, as well as passenger pick-up and drop-off spaces.

What is the Evergreen Line?

The Evergreen Line project is an 11-kilometre extension to the existing SkyTrain system in Metro Vancouver. It will be a fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service, connecting Coquitlam City Centre through Port Moody to Lougheed Town Centre in approximately 15 minutes. It will connect without transfer to the current SkyTrain network at Lougheed Town Centre Station and will integrate with regional bus and West Coast Express networks. When the line opens, Metro Vancouver's SkyTrain system will become the longest fully automated rapid transit system in the world.
