



## Station Plaza Construction

With construction of station buildings nearing completion, the Evergreen Line Project will begin building the station plaza areas in spring 2016. Station plazas are the public areas around the station and they include pedestrian walkways, passenger pick-up and drop off spaces, bike racks, landscaping, public seating, public art and, at some stations, bus loops and Park and Ride facilities. The station plazas are designed to be welcoming, functional public spaces that are accessible and sustainable.

Evergreen stations are designed to blend into their respective surrounding neighbourhoods, with a unique architectural look and feel. Station plaza areas are connected to the local community, and features such as outdoor furniture, pavement treatments and lighting will match the neighbourhood's local area plan. The exception is Moody Centre, a transit hub with a West Coast Express station. This plaza will have features that match those at other West Coast Express stations. Moody Centre and Coquitlam Central stations will have Park and Ride facilities.

Station plaza construction will begin in spring 2016 and continue until fall 2016. Access to businesses and public transit, including bus exchanges and West Coast Express, will be maintained at all times. Evergreen will be in service in early 2017.

### About the Evergreen Line Project

The Evergreen Line Project is an 11-kilometre extension to the existing SkyTrain system in Metro Vancouver. It will be a fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service, connecting Coquitlam City Centre through Port Moody to Lougheed Town Centre in approximately 15 minutes. It will connect without transfer to the current SkyTrain network at Lougheed Town Centre Station and will integrate with regional bus and West Coast Express networks. When the line opens, Metro Vancouver's SkyTrain system will become the longest fully automated rapid transit system in the world.
